The COVID-19 crisis has exponentially increased the urgency for leaders to adapt and evolve. You as the chief of staff have never been more center and critical to the success of not just responding to this urgency but helping build a sustainable path forward for your organization to stay proactive in adapting to future challenges.

This course is designed for chiefs of staff who must expand their influence to ensure organizational success at the most difficult time – where stakeholders may be remote, dispersed, and uncertain of the future.

Within an environment that is changing rapidly, chiefs will be equipped with the tools to create clarity for their role as chief, larger impact for their organization, their own professional development.

This course is over the span of 7 weeks and includes:

- Leader Behavior Diagnostic
- 4 Facilitated Sessions
- 3 Peer Coaching Sessions based on Leader Behavior Diagnostic results
- Capstone Project: Chiefs will be asked to define their current roles and responsibilities, the future state of this role, and how this role will support their own career development.

This series focuses not only on how chiefs can make their organizations more effective, but also how they as leaders can be even more influential.
